Summary of admission criteria for rehabilitation

at Attadale Rehabilitation Hospital

The patient must:

- Be medically stable and accepted by an accredited practitioner.
- Meet the requirements of the individual program, as outlined by the Guidelines for Recognition of Private Hospital-Based Rehabilitation Services (Aug 2016)
- Have rehabilitation goals achievable as an inpatient within an agreed timeframe.
- Be willing and able to participate in therapies provided.
- Be able to understand and retain information related to their physio and goals.
- Have an appropriate discharge plan in place.
- Have appropriate cover under their private health insurance, a DVA Gold card, or be self-funded. Cover under a DVA white card will require confirmation.

Exclusion criteria:

- A requirement for off-site treatment, e.g. chemotherapy, radiation therapy, immunotherapy, dialysis etc., due to interruption to therapies and transportation issues.
- New stomas (subject to change)
- New amputees
- CVA in the acute phase
- A requirement for blood transfusions
- Patients who do not have rehabilitation goals, e.g. respite

Attadale Rehabilitation Hospital provides:

- · Rehabilitation trained and experienced physiotherapists, occupational therapists and nursing staff
- CMO on site Monday to Friday 0800-1600
- Allied health services including (but not limited to) dietetics, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, speech and language therapy
